For 48 hours, around 15 teams of 3 people, composed of European animation students and professionals from production studios, will participate to a creative challenge: to produce 10 seconds of animation per team, based on a key image designed by a great name in animation (2012: Ben & Julia; 2013: Raoul Servais; 2014: Franck Dion ; 2015: Michel Ocelot).

Once the creative process is over, all the video sequences will be pieced together and mixed up with a soundtrack to create a short film that will be screened at the closing ceremony of the Fête de l'anim' on Sunday, March 27th.

THEME

Each team will have to use the key image at the beginning and at the end of their sequence.

CALENDRIER

Tuesday, March 22nd, 4pm: launch of the Marathon (unveiling of the image, start of the challenge) Thursday, March 24th, 4pm: film submission deadline Friday 25th et Saturday 26th : editing and sound designing by the organisers (while the teams enjoy the festival)

Sunday 27th, 9pm : public screening in the presence of the participants


